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Fine Entry Marine (FEM) is an Australian owned and operated business located in Geraldton, Western Australia.

Fine Entry Marine will utilise a number of SME's in Hobart during the construction phase of this contract and after the contract has been delivered to Hobart. It is estimated that approximately 15 Tasmanian jobs would be supported during this procurement activity. This includes utilising the services of a Tasmanian marine painter Derwent Marine to paint the vessel which gives the opportunity for them to employ extra staff to facilitate this contract being painted in Western Australia.

FEM is responsible for sourcing all goods and services throughout the contract and are eager to support Tasmanian Industry wherever possible during the construction phase and after delivery. FEM will support the Tasmanian market in sub-contracting labour, services and through purchasing products. The following shows existing suppliers and contactors that FEM have an established relationship with and intends to use for his contract who are SME's located in Tasmania.
