The Tasmanian Government is committed to maximising opportunities for local suppliers to compete for and win Government procurements. Suppliers/proponents are requested to prepare a Tasmanian Industry Participation Plan (TIPP):

- for all procurements with a value exceeding \$5 million;
- for nominated procurements (at the discretion of the procuring Government entity) greater than \$2 million and up to (and including) \$5 million; and
- for private sector projects valued at over \$5 million that receive support, including in-kind support, valued at or greater than \$500 000 from the Government.

Ambulance Private is a Tasmanian SME. It employs 37 local staff, of which 25 are supported by this Tender. 53798 Hrs have been logged by our staff in the last year. It is not envisaged our total staff numbers will change if we are successful in this Tender

Where are the goods or services to be used in the contract sourced from?

Ambulance Private will supply all services listed in the Tender "in-house". It is not envisaged we will out-source an estimate of locally sourced goods and services versus imported, but Ambulance Private currently spends \$579,000 in locally sourced goods and services

Opportunity for Tasmanian SME* involvement

Ambulance Private will not source components of our offer from other Tasmanian SME or sub-contractors. We are members of the TCCI.

Broader social and economic opportunities

Ambulance Private has a wage bill over over \$163,000 per year. All this money is paid into the Tasmanian economy. \$184,000 is paid into the local economy as a direct result of fleet maintenance. As we continue to train up new staff members we enhance the skill base in Tasmania. We will continue to employ new staff members as trainees in the field of PTO's. Ambulance Private does not currently employ disadvantaged Tasmanians but is open to future employment. Ambulance Private supports local communities, for example we have provided free medical support to the Royal Hobart Regatta for over twenty years.

Local innovative solutions

We do not value add to imported goods or services and are not developing strategies to provide goods or services to the Tasmanian economy that have been historically from interstate or overseas. Ambulance Private has elected to equip all of our vehicles with a comprehensive ambulance fitout, enabling them to be used in an emergency setting as support vehicles to the State.
