The Tasmanian Government is committed to maximising opportunities for local suppliers to compete for and win Government procurements. Suppliers/proponents are requested to prepare a Tasmanian Industry Participation Plan (TIPP):

- for all procurements with a value exceeding \$5 million;
- for nominated procurements (at the discretion of the procuring Government entity) greater than \$2 million and up to (and including) \$5 million; and
- for private sector projects valued at over \$5 million that receive support, including in-kind support, valued at or greater than \$500 000 from the Government.

Opportunity for Tasmanian SME* involvement

Opportunities to sub-contract and train resources in our methodologies and approaches will be actively sought to support both the Tasmanian Government requirements and potentially those of other clients in Tasmania and elsewhere. In this case our first preference will be to engage local personnel thereby providing employment opportunity and developing new skills and experiences.


For larger engagements we will work with stakeholders with the aim of engaging local SMEs to the value of at least 20% of the contract value and/or providing training opportunities for local students.

Broader social and economic opportunities

Knowledge and skills transfer will be a key feature of our planned engagement with the Tasmanian Government. We will seek avenues to transfer knowledge and skills to others involved (e.g. graduates) and other relevant personnel. This will include mentoring and professional development if desired by the Tasmania Government. For larger engagements, in consultation with the Tasmanian Government, we will offer training opportunities for local students and knowledge transfer opportunities for Tasmanian Government.

Local innovative solutions

Our services and methodologies are highly specialised and globally based. It is our intention to build local capability and leverage that capability to provide services interstate and overseas. We are very open to discussion to establish an expanded office in Tasmania to drive this growth and/or partner with a local organisation in this area.
