Executive summary

The upgrade of the Meadowbank Dam Spillway Crest Gates Cylinders and Controls by The Engineering Company (TEC) will positively impact local Tasmanian industry and economy and thereby the community as a whole for the following reasons:


TEC is a local Tasmanian Engineering services provider. With branches located at the Brighton Industrial Hub and Bass Highway, Somerset. Combined, we consist of approximately 100 full time employees in various trades, semi-skilled labour and apprentices.

Internally this project will support approximately 8 full time positions during each campaign. Internal combined hours totalling approximately 17,000 hrs.

Additional local goods and services will be required to assist us in these works. Sourced from local SME providers who are specialist in the fields of hydraulics (\$1.13M), electrical (\$0.69M), civil (\$0.33M) and surveying (\$0.2M).

Externally this project will support approximately up to 10-12 full time positions during each campaign through external SME's.

TEC and its sub-contractors will locally procure goods such as stainless-steel materials, electrical cabling and hydraulic components and hire equipment to support the project. As well as local accommodation, crane hire, transportation companies throughout the project durations. We envisage that 98% off purchases will be through local existing supply chains.



Approximately 15% of our workforce is made up of local apprentices comprised mainly in the fields of fitter / machinist and fabricator / welders. Over the last decade, TEC has annually recruited additional apprentices with good retention outcomes. Some of them will be involved in this project.

Over recent years, TEC has made small contributions to local sporting activities. Such as local cricket, netball, and badminton.

Almost all items are being sourced through local suppliers and any raw materials coming from overseas, such as raw stainless-steel materials and cabling, will be value added through manufacturing processes and or installation / fitment.
