

Routine Disclosure of Overall Government Procurement Statistics

Tasmanian Government agencies¹ required to comply with the Treasurer's Instructions must publish awarded contract information on the Tenders website. This applies to all procurement contracts valued at \$50 000 or greater.

Below is a snapshot of current procurement statistics for the most recent four quarters.

Information in the table below relates to contracts valued at \$50 000 or more awarded as a result of the following open procurement processes: Request for Tender, Request for Proposal and Expression of Interest^{2 3}.

Please note, a Tasmanian business is a business operating within Tasmania that has a permanent office or presence in Tasmania and which employs Tasmanian workers.

³ On 1 September 2023, the threshold above which agencies must undertake an open tender process for the procurement of building and construction works increased from \$250 000 to \$500 000. This may impact the comparability of prior quarterly data relating to open procurement processes.
