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### Executive summary

Logsys recognise the importance of local industry participation in its supply chain. However, this is a material only contract so opportunities to involve local suppliers are limited. TasNetworks can be assured that when the possibility arises local companies will be considered in the supply chain.

Our solution for TasNetworks includes the provisioning of tools and equipment. Whilst the manufacturer specifies the mandatory use of some tools the balance will be supplied from local companies. Logistics will be another opportunity to have a local company provide services. Products will be shipped from the mainland by ferry and transported to Hobart by a local company.

The installation of our reinforcing system will be done by TasNetworks employees.

There will be other opportunities to train, and employ local labour should some of the additional services be added to the contract.

Logsys, as it has done in other Australian States and Territories and in New Zealand has expanded its business into these locations. There is no reason that with this tender as the base other services for asset infrastructure maintenance would not lead to the generation of an operation into Tasmania.

If this materialises it would be an opportunity to increase local industry participation from employment, through premises rent, office supply and operation to vehicle and equipment purchases and operations.

Logsys and its US head office see this tender as the first rung in the ladder of expansion into Tasmania and furthering its relationship with local industry.
